

## **CONDITIONS**

for Participation in the International Tournament to be held in Abu Dhabi, UAE, from December 16, 2026, to December 22, 2026, titled “World Tactical Sport”

### **1. PREAMBLE**

1.1. These Conditions for Participation in the International Tournament to be held in Abu Dhabi, UAE, from December 16, 2026, to December 22, 2026, titled “World Tactical Sport” (“the Conditions”), are an integral part of the Rules and Regulations, as well as part of the Regulatory Documents governing the organization and holding of the (“WTS”).

1.2. Participants in the World Tactical Sport are those who submit an application for participation in the World Tactical Sport (“the Application”) in accordance with the terms outlined in the Rules and Regulations, as well as in the Regulatory Documents. For the purposes of the Conditions, “participants” refers to either individuals or legal entities (“the Participant”).

1.3. By submitting the Application, the Participant affirms that upon approval Tactical community (“TC”), they will be fully bound by the Rules and Regulations (including, but not limited to, the Conditions) and all the Regulatory Documents.

1.4. Unless otherwise defined herein, capitalized terms used herein shall have the meaning set forth in the Rules and Regulations, as well as in the Regulatory Documents (as amended and supplemented from time to time).

### **2. GENERAL PROVISIONS**

2.1. In accordance with the terms of the Conditions, TC undertakes to take all necessary measures to organize and facilitate the Participant’s participation in the World Tactical Sport, in compliance with the provisions outlined in the Rules and Regulations, the Regulatory Documents, and/or any other relevant documents issued by TC. The Participant undertakes to participate in the World Tactical Sport strictly in accordance with its calendar/schedule, adhering to the requirements set forth in the Rules and Regulations, the Regulatory Documents, and/or any other relevant documents issued by TC, as well as the Conditions. The Participant acknowledges that the World Tactical Sport is not intended for advertising goods, services, or works. No fees will be charged for participation in the World Tactical Sport. The Participant agrees to act with integrity and fairness at all times.

2.2. By submitting the Application, the Participant agrees:

- To grant TC an irrevocable, worldwide, royalty-free license and/or permission to use, reproduce, and distribute their image (including photographs and videos), as well as any graphical representations and other visual depictions of their likeness. This includes, but is not limited to, their appearance, stylized and photographic images, movements, symbols, and other visual identifiers; their full name (surname, first name, patronymic), pseudonym; their voice; autograph; and any other personal attributes for commercial purposes. The Participant acknowledges and agrees that TC may transfer these rights to third parties for non-commercial purposes without further consent or compensation;
- To consent to TC recording photographs and videos during the competitions or any other events within the framework of the World Tactical Sport in which they participate and grants permission for these recordings to be publicly broadcast and retransmitted by any means, including on TC’s online platforms and in publicly accessible formats, for commercial purposes.

The Participant understands that this may include use in promotional materials, advertisements, and various forms of media;

To consent to TC recording of their gameplay, commentary, and any other interactions during live streaming, online broadcasts, and other forms of media coverage. TC is granted the right to edit and distribute such recordings across various platforms without requiring further consent or compensation;

To transfer to TC all rights to any intellectual property created during the competitions or any other events within the framework of the World Tactical Sport that involve their participation. This includes, but is not limited to, any materials, content, or productions resulting from their involvement or engagement, with the understanding that such rights are granted without expectation of compensation; and

To processing of the Participant's personal data by TC, including, but not limited to: full name, passport data, date of birth, photographs, video and audio recordings with the Participant's participation, e-mail and phone number, and any other personal data provided by the Participant for the purposes of participation in the World Tactical Sport. The Participant acknowledges that they have read and fully understand the implications of the Conditions regarding the use of their likeness and contributions. They agree that this grant of rights is essential for the promotion and operation of the World Tactical Sport and that they will not hold TC liable for any claims, damages, or liabilities related to the use of their image or contributions as outlined herein.

2.2.1. The consent and rights provided for in Clause [Ошибка! Источник ссылки не найден.](#) hereof are granted by the Participant to TC:

- On a non-exclusive basis;
- For a variety of purposes, including, but not limited to, commercial, marketing, advertising, informational, and any other commercial or non-commercial activities;
- In their entirety, in parts, or in any combination thereof;
- Without any limitations regarding the duration of use or geographical territory (applicable worldwide);
- Without any obligation for TC to make payments to the Participant.

2.2.2. The Participant acknowledges that any materials, products, or intellectual property created using, based on, or incorporating their image rights, as described in the Conditions, during the period of their consent may be utilized by TC without restrictions on duration or territory. The Participant understands and agrees that such materials will not be subject to deletion or removal at their request, except in instances where such use would unlawfully infringe upon the Participant's privacy, dignity, or reputation.

2.2.3. The Participant hereby confirms that the consent and rights specified in Clause 2.2 hereof have been granted to TC and will remain effective until such time as this consent is revoked in writing by submitting a written statement by the Participant to TC at [legal@worldtacticalsport.com](mailto:legal@worldtacticalsport.com). The Participant understands that withholding their personal data may limit TC's ability to operate effectively. Any data processing completed before revocation remains lawful. Without this consent, their non-public personal and health data will not be shared, and the Participant will not be eligible to participate in the World Tactical Sport. If the

Participant withdraws their consent, their participation will end. TC may continue to use publicly available personal data of the Participant after the Participant revokes their consent.

2.2.4. The Participant acknowledges that engaging in the World Tactical Sport carries inherent risks that could jeopardize their life and health, potentially resulting in injury or harm. By voluntarily participating in the World Tactical Sport, the Participant agrees to release TC from any liability for any injuries or damages sustained, including those caused by the actions of other competitors who may violate the Rules and Regulations, the Regulatory Documents, and any other relevant documents issued by TC, or due to unforeseen accidents.

2.2.5. The Participant agrees to accept and abide by all decisions made by TC regarding the organization and execution of the World Tactical Sport. This includes adherence to any rules, guidelines, or changes implemented by TC to ensure a fair and safe environment for all Participants.

2.3. Upon submitting the Application, the Participant agrees to provide TC with the following documents:

- Acknowledgement of Understanding (except for the team’s staff);
- Waiver of Liability, Assumption of Risk, and Indemnity Agreement (except for the team’s staff);
- Travel insurance;
- Medical certificate (except for the team’s staff);
- Consent to the processing of personal data;
- Parents’ (legal representative’s) consent (if applicable).

### **3. RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS**

3.1. TC has the right to:

3.1.1. To require the Participant to rectify any breaches of the Conditions, the Rules and Regulations, the Regulatory Documents, and any other relevant documents issued by TC. TC may suspend or prohibit the Participant from participating in the WTS if:

- The Participant does not comply with the requirements of the Rules and Regulations, the Regulatory Documents, and any other relevant documents issued by TC; and/or
- The Participant failed to adhere to the requirements set forth in the Rules and Regulations, the Regulatory Documents, and any other relevant documents issued by TC; and/or
- The Participant does not correct any violations of the Rules and Regulations, the Regulatory Documents, and any other relevant documents issued by TC, as well as the Conditions; and/or
- The Participant received a refusal to issue an accreditation card in the manner prescribed by the Rules and Regulations, the Regulatory Documents, and any other relevant documents issued by TC; and/or
- The Participant provides false, inaccurate, and/or incomplete information necessary for participation in the WTS, or if the Participant refuses to update such information; and/or

- The Participant fails to comply with all laws and regulations applicable in the UAE and align with the morals and customs of the UAE, including, but not limited to, the TDRA Guidelines; and/or
- The content created, shared, or promoted by the Participant in connection with the WTS, and/or if any content associated with the Participant’s involvement in the WTS, including, but not limited to, any content published on social media platforms, does not align with all laws and regulations applicable in the UAE, with the morals and customs of the UAE, including, but not limited to, the TDRA Guidelines; and/or
- In any other circumstances deemed appropriate by TC at its sole discretion.

3.1.2. To distribute newsletters and communications to the Participant.

3.1.3. To process and publish on their Internet resources, online platforms, the information provided by the Participant, including, but not limited to, its structuring, editing, combining, separating, translating the text into foreign languages, and performing other similar actions with that information.

3.1.4. To deprive the Participant of the rights under the Conditions and unilaterally terminate the Conditions in case of receiving information about violations by the Participant of the Rules and Regulations, the Regulatory Documents, and any other relevant documents issued by TC, as well as the Conditions.

3.1.5. To utilize, at its sole discretion and without requiring consent from the Participant or providing any compensation, including for commercial purposes, any means of creating and/or using (including, but not limited to, reproduction, distribution, broadcasting, cable communication, public communication, processing) the Participant’s image. This includes, but is not limited to, photographs, videos, full name, voice, pseudonym, signature, handwriting samples, physical appearance and its components, images of tattoos, stylized and photographic representations, slogans, popular expressions, symbols, movements, and other personal attributes.

3.1.6. To exercise its rights and obligations by engaging third parties to fulfill these purposes without additional notification to the Participant.

3.1.7. To exclude from participation in a team any Participant who fails to utilize tickets provided by TC for travel to the WTS premises, WTS venue, or WTS facilities due to their own fault

3.1.8. To modify the calendar of the WTS, the schedule of matches, duels, or races, or to terminate the competitions, matches, duels, or races within the framework of the WTS at its sole discretion, without incurring any additional obligations to the team or the Participant.

3.1.9. To exercise any other rights as stipulated by the applicable laws, the Rules and Regulations, the Regulatory Documents, and any other relevant documents issued by TC, as well as the terms of the Conditions.

3.2. TC undertakes:

3.2.1. To organize and conduct the WTS in accordance with the Rules and Regulations and the applicable laws, taking all necessary measures to facilitate the Participant’s involvement in the WTS.

3.2.2. To grant the Participant access to the WTS, contingent upon the timely fulfillment of all requirements stipulated by the Conditions, the Rules and Regulations, the Regulatory Documents, and any other relevant documents issued by TC.

3.2.3. To maintain effective communication with the Participant, including updates regarding their Application for the WTS.

3.2.4. To arrange accommodation for the Participant in a hotel or other lodging facilities, with the specific choice of location, category, and level of service being determined solely by TC.

3.2.5. To provide meals for the Participant at their accommodation during the WTS.

3.2.6. To supply the necessary inventory and equipment required for the Participant's participation in the WTS at training and competition venues, unless otherwise specified in the Rules and Regulations.

3.2.7. To arrange travel for the Participant to and from the WTS venue by purchasing air, railway, or other necessary tickets on a one-time basis. TC is not obligated to repurchase tickets for any Participant who fails to utilize previously provided tickets. The class of travel, route, and other parameters will be determined at the sole discretion of TC.

3.2.8. To fulfill any additional obligations as mandated by the applicable laws, the Rules and Regulations, the Regulatory Documents, and any other relevant documents issued by TC.

3.3. The Participant has the right to:

3.3.1. To participate in the competitions and any other events within the framework of the WTS in accordance with the terms of the Conditions, the Rules and Regulations, the Regulatory Documents, and any other relevant documents issued by TC.

3.3.2. To provide, update, or change the information about themselves specified in the Conditions, if necessary, in accordance with the procedure provided for by the Rules and Regulations, the Regulatory Documents, and any other relevant documents issued by TC.

3.3.3. To exercise any other rights provided by the applicable laws, the Rules and Regulations, the Regulatory Documents, and any other relevant documents issued by TC.

3.4. The Participant undertakes:

3.4.1. To participate actively and appropriately in the competitions and any other events within the framework of the WTS throughout its entire duration, adhering to the established calendar and schedule of events as outlined in the Conditions, the Rules and Regulations, the Regulatory Documents, and any other relevant documents issued by TC.

3.4.2. To familiarize themselves with, comply with, and execute all provisions of the Conditions, the Rules and Regulations, the Regulatory Documents, and any other relevant documents issued by TC, as well as the relevant documents of WTC (if applicable).

3.4.3. To submit all necessary information and documentation required for admission to participate in the WTS within the deadlines specified by the Rules and Regulations, the Regulatory Documents, and any other relevant documents issued by TC.

3.4.4. To provide TC with their banking details upon request, ensuring timely communication of any updates or changes to this information.

3.4.5. To grant permission to TC to create and utilize their image through any means necessary (including, but not limited to, reproduction, distribution, broadcasting, cable communication, public communication, and processing) and through any technologies available. This includes, but is not limited to, photographs, videos, graphic representations, full name, voice, pseudonym, signature, handwriting samples, physical appearance and its components, images of tattoos, stylized and photographic depictions, slogans, popular expressions, symbols, movements, and any other personal attributes that may serve to identify the Participant.

3.4.6. To actively participate (and ensure the Participant's participation) in the WTS and other related events (including media events, media days, autograph sessions, sponsor activations, filming in promotional materials, etc.) as directed by TC, using the agreed uniform, outfit, inventory, and equipment in accordance with the requirements of the Rules and Regulations, the Regulatory Documents, and any other relevant documents issued by TC. The Participant also agrees to engage in interviews (including flash interviews) as directed by TC. The procedure for participation in such events may be further detailed in the Rules and Regulations and other documents or instructions provided by TC.

3.4.7. To refrain from engaging in any acts that are prohibited by the applicable laws, the Rules and Regulations, the Regulatory Documents, and any other relevant documents issued by TC, as well as the relevant documents of WTC (if applicable).

3.4.8. To maintain confidentiality regarding any sensitive information pertaining to TC, WTC, and the organization and hosting of the WTS that comes to their knowledge as a result of their participation.

3.4.9. Not to interfere with PI's activities that are aimed at organizing and conducting the WTS.

3.4.10. Not to engage in any actions that could disrupt the normal progression of the WTS or cause harm, including damage to the reputation of the WTS, TC, its representatives, judges, or other participants.

3.4.11. Not to assign or transfer their rights and obligations under the Conditions to any third parties without the prior written consent from TC.

3.4.12. Not to unlawfully influence the results of competitions/matches/duels and any other events conducted within the framework of the WTS.

3.4.13. Not to engage personally, nor to allow relatives, natural or legal guardians, spouses, or any other individuals to participate in gambling activities through bookmakers by placing bets on matches or duels within the framework of the WTS, as well as on any official sports competitions across various sports disciplines.

3.4.14. Not to obstruct the process of being replaced by another participant of the WTS in the manner prescribed by the Rules and Regulations.

3.4.15. To coordinate with TC regarding the submission of a written application for withdrawal from the WTS, ensuring that all necessary protocols are followed.

3.4.16. To accept and comply with all sports sanctions imposed by TC and authorized bodies of the WTS, in accordance with the applicable laws, the Rules and Regulations, the Regulatory Documents, and any other relevant documents issued by TC.

3.4.17. To arrive at the designated accommodation, training facilities, the WTS venues, the WTS premises, the WTS facilities, and any other related locations no later than the date and time set

by TC. The Participant must not alter and/or add any information to their travel documents (such as tickets, boarding passes, itinerary receipts, etc.).

3.4.18. To inform TC about any potential sponsors or partners prior to signing any relevant agreements. The Participant will enter into sponsorship agreements only with the written preliminary approval of TC and will disclose any entities interested in collaborating with them, including those wishing to sponsor their participation in the WTS or to utilize their image, clothing, or likeness for advertising and promotional purposes.

3.4.19. To refrain from any form of insult, disrespect, immorality, defamatory, or offensiveness and from engaging in any actions or making statements that could negatively impact themselves or other participants in the WTS, as well as the WTS itself, TC, WTC (including its members), and any sponsors, advertisers, or marketing partners, and any other persons/entities associated with TC or the WTC. The Participant must treat all individuals involved with respect and refrain from any form of insult, disrespect, immorality, defamatory, or offensiveness.

3.4.20. To secure a personal travel insurance policy and any additional coverage (insurance) necessary for the Participant's participation in the WTS, unless otherwise specified by the Rules and Regulations, the Regulatory Documents, and any other relevant documents issued by TC. The Participant must provide TC with an original copy of this insurance policy, which must be valid for the entire duration of the WTS, and assumes responsibility for ensuring that the coverage is adequate according to the relevant insurance policy.

3.4.21. To utilize their official public social media channels to share information promoting the WTS and corresponding to the objectives and general image concept of the WTS, at the direction of TC and within the time period specified by TC; the procedure for posting publications can be detailed by the Rules and Regulations and other documents/instructions issued by TC.

3.4.22. To take part in surveys, voting, questionnaires, and/or other research initiatives conducted on behalf of TC and/or third parties authorized by TC, the results of which may be used by TC in an aggregated form.

3.4.23. To fulfill any additional responsibilities as mandated by the applicable laws, the Rules and Regulations, the Regulatory Documents, and any other relevant documents issued by TC pertaining to the WTS.

3.4.24. To comply with all laws and regulations applicable in the UAE and align with the morals and customs of the UAE, including, but not limited to, the TDRA Guidelines. The Participant understands that any content associated with their participation in this WTS must adhere to these standards and regulations.

3.4.25. To be solely responsible for ensuring that any content they create, share, or promote in connection with the WTS does not violate all laws and regulations applicable in the UAE and align with the morals and customs of the UAE, including, but not limited to, the TDRA Guidelines. Should any content be found in violation, the Participant agrees to amend such content at their own expense upon notification by TC. Furthermore, this Participant's obligation applies equally to content published on social media platforms. The Participant must ensure that any posts, comments, or shared materials on social media adhere to the same legal and ethical standards and do not infringe upon the rights or reputations of others. Any violations identified in social media content will also require the Participant to promptly rectify them at their own expense. The Participant agrees to indemnify and hold harmless TC, its affiliates, and their respective officers, directors, employees, and agents from any claims, damages, or liabilities

arising from the Participant's failure to comply with the obligation specified herein or the applicable laws and regulations.

3.5. The Participant acknowledges that they have read and will comply with all the Rules and Regulations, the Regulatory Documents including, but not limited to, health and safety rules and regulations and all applicable security requirements that apply from time to time at the WTS premises and all WTS venues or as otherwise notified by ASPIRE UAE – Sole Proprietorship LLC, a company established under the laws of the UAE, having its principal offices at Accelerator 2 Building, Plot M12, Masdar City, Abu Dhabi, UAE (“Aspire”), or Ethara – Sole Proprietorship LLC, a company duly incorporated in the Emirate of Abu Dhabi, UAE, and with its registered office at PO Box 130001, Abu Dhabi, UAE (“Ethara”). The Participant also agrees to comply with any terms, conditions, and limitations imposed on Aspire or Ethara under any third-party contracts, including, but not limited to, any venue agreements. The Participant accepts that they are accountable to Aspire and Ethara for their compliance with the regulations specified in this Clause and for any consequences arising from their noncompliance. The Participant recognizes their responsibility to adhere to the specific regulations set forth by ABU DHABI NATIONAL EXHIBITIONS COMPANY (ADNEC) - PJSC and any other relevant authorities. The Participant's participation in the WTS is contingent upon their adherence to the commitments specified in this Clause. Additionally, the Participant commits to ensuring that their conduct and actions during the WTS do not disrupt the experience of other athletes or violate any established protocols. The Participant will remain informed of any changes to the rules and regulations throughout the duration of the WTS and will seek clarification from TC, Aspire, or Ethara if needed.

3.6. In return for being permitted to participate in the following activity or program, including any associated use of the premises, facilities, staff, equipment, transportation, the Participant releases, waives and promises not to sue TC, its directors, officers, employees, and agents, subcontractors from liability from any and all claims, including the negligence of TC, resulting in personal injury (including death), emotional injury, accidents or illnesses, and property loss, in connection with participation in the WTS and any use of premises, facilities. For clarification, the Participant will sign a separate Waiver of Liability, Assumption of Risk, and Indemnity Agreement detailing these terms.

#### **4. LIABILITY. SANCTIONS**

4.1. The Participant and TC are responsible for non-fulfillment or improper fulfillment of their obligations under the Conditions in accordance with the applicable laws, the Rules and Regulations, the Regulatory Documents, any other relevant documents issued by TC, as well as the Conditions.

4.2. In case the Participant violates the Rules and Regulations, the Regulatory Documents, any other relevant documents issued by TC, as well as the Conditions, TC has the right to apply disciplinary action or sports sanctions to the Participant in the manner prescribed by the Rules and Regulations, the Regulatory Documents, and any other relevant documents issued by TC.

4.3. If the Participant fails to meet its obligations under the Conditions or is disqualified, TC may recover any costs incurred to support the Participant's involvement in the WTS.

#### **5. FORCE MAJEURE**

5.1. The Participant and TC are released from liability for partial or complete non-fulfillment of obligations under the Conditions if this non-fulfillment was the result of force majeure

circumstances that arose after submitting the Application as a result of extraordinary events that neither of them could foresee or prevent by reasonable measures (force majeure). Such force majeure circumstances include: flood, fire, earthquake, explosion, storm, subsidence of soil, epidemic and other natural phenomena, war or military actions, as well as the issuance by the competent state body of an act that makes it impossible for the Participant or TC to fulfill their obligations under the Conditions (including the introduction of restrictive measures in connection with the threat of the spread of coronavirus infection, including, in the form of a ban on holding any mass and other measures, suspension/termination in connection with such restrictions on the activities of state (municipal) bodies and organizations, the introduction of non-working days during the period of restrictive measures).

5.2. The entity referring to force majeure circumstances is obliged to inform the other entity in writing about the occurrence of such circumstances no later than 2 (Two) days after their occurrence.

5.3. Upon termination of the specified circumstances, the entity referring to their effect must immediately notify the other entity in writing.

5.4. In the event of force majeure circumstances, the deadline for the fulfillment of obligations under the Conditions is postponed in proportion to the time during which such circumstances and their consequences apply.

## **6. DISPUTE RESOLUTION**

6.1. The Conditions and any dispute or claim (including non-contractual dispute or claim) arising in connection with the Conditions, the subject matter or conclusion hereof, shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of England and Wales.

6.2. Any dispute, controversy or claim arising out of or in connection with the Conditions, including any matter concerning the existence, validity or termination hereof, shall be settled by the parties through negotiations. If the parties fail to reach a settlement through negotiations within 30 (Thirty) days from the date a dispute arises, any of the parties may refer to and finally resolved by arbitration under the Arbitration Rules of the London Court of International Arbitration, which Rules are deemed to be incorporated by reference into this Clause. The number of arbitrators shall be three. The seat, or legal place, of arbitration shall be the DIFC. The language to be used in the arbitration shall be English. The governing law of the arbitration agreement shall be the substantive laws of England and

## **7. FINAL PROVISIONS**

7.1. TC reserves the right to amend or modify the Conditions at any time prior to the commencement of the WTS.

7.2. The Conditions, together with the Rules and Regulations, the Regulatory Documents, and any other relevant documents issued by TC, constitute the entire agreement between the Participant and TC regarding participation in the WTS. No other agreements or understandings, whether written or oral, shall be deemed to exist or bind the parties.

7.3. If any provision of the Conditions is found to be invalid or unenforceable by a competent authority, the remaining provisions shall be valid and enforceable to the fullest extent permitted by the applicable laws.

7.4. It is allowed to send correspondence via electronic communication (e-mail) to the addresses specified in the Application and on the official website of the WTS.

7.5. If an issue is not addressed by the Conditions, the Rules and Regulations, the Regulatory Documents, or any other relevant documents issued by TC, the applicable laws shall apply.
